I'm optimistic that we're in for another year of continued growth and success thanks to each and everyone of you who are contributing to make those goals a reality.

BPX REGISTRATION ALMOST HERE!

BPX Trip Registration begins April 1 at 6AM (no April Fooling). Starting this date, all scheduled BPX Trips will be open up for sign-up. So study the BPX Trip Catalog to figure out the Backpacking and Camping trips that are calling to you, and grab a cup of coffee and fire up the computer on April 1st!

Remember that in order to give more BPX Members a chance of going on a trip, registration is initially restricted to 3 BPX backpacking and/or camping trips, whether you are on 3 separate trip rosters, 3 waitlists, or a combination thereof. On the 20th of each month, the *BackCountry Cache* Newsletter will publish BPX trips for the following month that still have openings. At that time members can sign up for a trip, regardless of how many BPX Trips they have already registered for.

The Trip Catalog Spreadsheet in the link below can be sorted by any column desired, and the sort will apply to only the spreadsheet in your local browser session; the master document will not be impacted. In the first column is a link to the trip on the CMC website where you can see more details about a trip. BPX TIP OF THE MONTH

Finding BPX Trips on CMC Website

There are a number of ways to find a trip on the CMC website--here are some for locating BPX Backpacking and Camping trips.

Using the FILTER OPTIONS

First, go to the Education and Adventure tab at the top of the main CMC home page and select Find Trips.

To Find All Backpacking Section (BPX) Trips:

• Enter BPX (or bpx) in the Search Box at the top of the menu on the left-hand side of the page and select the SEARCH button. (This is the most certain way of finding BPX trips).

OR

• Using the menu on the left-hand side of the page, scroll down to "With this group/Section..." and select the box next to Backpacking Section.

To further refine the BPX trips selected above you can do one of the following:

- Filter by Activity:
 - Under the "I want to go ... " menu block, select the box next to Backpacking to see just the BPX backpacking trips OR *Camping* to see just the BPX camping trips.

Note: If you do not filter to get just the BPX trips in one of the ways described above but just select the Backpacking or the Camping Activity, you will also get other trips that are not part of the BPX catalog.

- Filter by Date:
 - Under the "Starting..." menu block, enter a start and an end date for your search. Note: You must enter both a start and end date for the date filter to kick in.

You can also add other filters like a Trip Leader Name or a Difficulty Rating like Easy or Moderate.

To Find a Particular BPX Trip:

In the Search Box at the top of the FIND TRIPS page, you can enter a portion of the trip's title and then click on the SEARCH button.

Examples:

- To find the trip "Backpack BPX 6-Day: Tour of Mount Zirkel Wilderness Lakes from Katherine TH", you could enter Tour of Mount Zirkel Wilderness.
- To find the trip "Camp BPX 3-Day: The Crags Campground at State Forest State Park", you could enter Crags Campground.

Note: The search will not work if you enter the entire title; you need to leave out at least the "-" in the trip name following "Backpack" or "Camp"; e.g., Backpack BPX 6-Day: Tour of Mount Zirkel Wilderness Lakes from Katherine TH.

Using the CMC CALENDAR

- To access the CMC calendar, click the three lines above the word More in the upper right corner of the main CMC home page. Then select EVENTS to bring up the CMC Event calendar. Note that this will display a calendar with ALL CMC events, trips, and courses.
- To access just the BACKPACKING SECTION CALENDAR, click the three lines above the word More in the upper right corner of the home page, followed by Groups & Sections, followed by Special Interest Groups. On the SPECIAL INTEREST SECTION page that comes up, either choose Backpacking Section under the options on the left OR click the BACKPACKING SECTION (BPX): Button in the main part of the page. Once on the BACKPACKING SECTION page, under the dark grey box on the right listing the Upcoming Events and Trips is a Calendar of Upcoming Events and Trips link that will take you to just the BPX Calendar.

To sign up for any trip from the calendar view, select the title of the trip. This will bring up a box with summary information about the trip. Select the Trip Title again to go to the actual Trip page where you can sign up.
